Operational procedures for the beginning of the new term in September

Dear Parents,

Please find below the operational procedures for the next academic year. These processes have been constructed after adapting some of the procedures that have actually benefited our children during and after the Covid pandemic. This has led us to look at what procedures we have been able to abandon, adopt and adapt to better benefit the smooth running of the school.

If you have siblings in both key stages, could you please drop off at the Key Stage 2 time and pick up at the Key Stage 1 time. (For example if you have a child in Year 5 and Year 2 both children will be dropped off at 8:45am and picked up at 3:10pm).

School Uniform

School uniform will be as normal: <u>uniform-policy.pdf (primarysite-prod-sorted.s3.amazonaws.com)</u>

However, on the days your children have P.E and/or forest schools the children will come into school wearing the appropriate kit for the full day, so they have more time for lessons rather that getting changed. But this will still also be in line with the school uniform policy (no branded football shirts etc.) For example if your children have P.E on a Tuesday they come to school wearing their school P.E kit for the full day. Experience has shown that this benefits much smoother transitions and leads to more teaching contact time for the children. If your child has P.E and Forest Schools on the same day, please send them in their P.E kit, with suitable Forest School kit (e.g over trousers/wellington boots etc) in a bag.











The P.E. and Forest School timetables (see below) will begin from next week w/c 05.09.22 apart from Reception Children (Little Conkers Class) whose P.E and Forest School timetable will begin w/c 19.09.22

Therefore, Year 3/4 (Sycamore Class) should come into school wearing Forest Schools kit for the 1st day back (Monday 5th September). Everyone else (including Reception children) are to come in on the first day wearing their normal school uniform.
